Homeless Programs



Northern Oxford County

Strafford Ave. Family Center:

- Provides emergency shelter to one homeless family at a time.
- Located in a large 4 bedroom house in Rumford.

Homeless Youth Outreach Program:

- Provides community support services to youth ages 16-24 years old who are lacking adult supervision and/or a permanent/legal residency.

Transitional Living Program:

- Provides scattered site housing to homeless youth ages 18-21 in community based apartments for up to 18 months.
- The goal of the program is assist youth in making a successful transition to self sufficiency and independent living.

Franklin Ave. Transitional Housing Program:

- Located in Rumford, The program has 3 apartments which have project based section 8 vouchers.
- It serves three homeless youth/young families ages 18-28.
- It consists of two 3-bedroom apartments and one 1-bedroom apartment.
- Tenants are offered affordable housing, supportive services and individualized case management.
- Tenants can remain in the program for two years while they develop the skills needed for self-sufficiency.

Southern Oxford & Northern Cumberland Counties

Norway Family Center:

- Provides emergency shelter for up to 12 homeless women and children or 3-4 families at a time.
- Located in Norway, there is a live-in House Manager who provides day to day assistance. All guests receive case management services to help them eliminate their homeless situation.

South Paris Men's Shelter:

- This shelter serves up to two single men at any given time.
- Guests receive supportive and case management services.

Homeless Youth Outreach Program:

- Provides community support services to youth ages 16-24 years old who are lacking adult supervision and/or a permanent/legal residency.

Transitional Living Program:

- Provides scattered site housing to homeless youth ages 18-21 in community based apartments for up to 18 months.

- Located in Norway, Pinewoods offers permanent housing, supportive services and individualized case management services.
- It can serve 4 homeless families/individuals ages 18-28 who have a disability.
- There are two 3-bedroom units, one 2-bedroom unit, and one handicap accessible 1-bedroom unit.
